**H**aiti has more than 4-million children. Many will never read and write.

Only 48% of Haitian boys and 52% of Haitian girls attend primary school. 15% who start 1st grade do not make it to grade 6.

The odds of a Haitian child getting a high-school education are worse. Only 18% of young Haitian men and 21% of young Haitian women attend secondary school.

Impoverishment drives too, too many Haitian children from school into an unskilled labor force that employs 21% of Haiti's children of all ages.

Help us help Haiti's children to develop life skills in the classrooms of our K-12 school in Thomassin. Help these young people stay in school. Their futures begin to change when you sponsor a classroom for \$25 a month.



*This third-grade class counts 42 students and one teacher. Together they create a space where everyone learns. Some classes in our school total 65 students. Their diligence creates the happiness of young boys and girls who appreciate the privilege of an education.*
